### **Here's directions to find the AGM, and where to park:**

The auditorium is located in the lower level of the K.C. Irving Building, which is located on the west side of University Ave. about half way up the hill. Metered parking can be located along the bottom part of University Ave. and in the lot directly across the road from the front doors of the Irving Centre. There is also metered parking at the athletic center, located at the bottom of University Ave. across Main Street. Free parking can be found on Westwood Ave. (the street parallel to University Ave., one block west) or in the Acadia free parking lot which is in the South/East corner of Campus (off of Highland Ave. beside Tower Residence). (Note that the free parking lot is located on the other side of campus so you will have to walk across campus to get to the Irving Building)
